Question: Agricultural Development and Marketing Authority

ANSWER

At the request of the outgoing board members of the Agricultural Development and Marketing Authority (ADMA), officers of the Department of Primary Industry and Fisheries are currently preparing a paper, which will review the operations of the authority during its 10-year life. The document is intended to provided in some detail, the objectives set for the ADMA and the comparative results, achievements and disappointments.
