- 2. For each year from 2010-2020 for each school please provide:a) The school budget
- 3. Please provide the 2021 budget for schools in Lajamanu, Areyonga, Willowra, Yuendumu and Numbulwar.
- 4. For the years 2010-2021 for each community school please provide:
 - a) The enrolment data
 - b) The attendance data
 - c) Projected budgets for 2022
- For 2019 (the most recent financial data for schools provided in My Schools) for each of the community schools please show how the School Resourcing Package¹ – as published on the My School website – was distributed between:
 - a) Direct funding school managed and centrally managed
 - Indirect funding resources for the Department's Education NT's strategic focus
- 6. For 2019 for each community school, please provide a list of the "additional resources"² the Department provided to these schools to support the

Important information to be considered when analyzing the responses to the written questions.

- All answers provided are based on the data available as at 30 November 2021.
- The written questions seek information from of different reporting sources and systems, such as My School and the department's School Resource Model (SRM). It is important to note the distinctions between the different types of financial information provided and acknowledge that they cannot be accurately compared:
 - SRM financial data includes department allocated funds, based around needs-based funding methodology, for schools to manage. This funding includes pre-school, school managed fixed costs (minor repairs and maintenance); targeted program funding, employee and operational costs and school managed program delivery. SRM data excludes centrally managed costs such as principal salaries, study leave, parental leave, and school managed fund-raising (school council activities). SRM data does not include resources provided by other NT departments, such as teacher housing, long service leave, centrally provided payroll or ICT services, or school repairs and maintenance (managed by the Department of Planning, Infrastructure and Logistics). SRM is a partial component of the data that is contributed to My School reporting,
 - SRM related questions are Q2, Q3, Q4, Q7 and Q8.
 - My School financial data includes all Australian Government and department funding sources to schools (school and centrally managed funds, along with resources provided by other departments, such as teacher housing, long service leave, centrally provided payroll or ICT services, or school repairs and maintenance), however, it excludes pre-school funding and school managed fund-raising (school council activities).
 - My School related questions are Q1 and Q5.
