1. Please provide a copy of the Work Health and Safety (WHS) report that was conducted on two rural stations last year, namely Humpty Doo and Virginia?

WHS reports are not provided as they are operational internal documents.

2. Did the Humpty Doo and Virginia Stations pass their WHS inspections?

Workplace Health and Safety inspections do not produce a pass/fail result.

3. If not, what defects were found and have these been rectified?

Workplace Health and Safety Inspections do not identify defects.

4. Do you have plans to undertake any further WHS inspections of volunteer firefighter Brigades and remote stations in 2022?

Yes.

5. Can the Northern Territory Government provide an assurance that all volunteer fire stations are fit for purpose?

The Northern Territory Police, Fire and Emergency Service asset management matches assets with business service objectives and optimises performance throughout the useful life of the asset.

6. If not, what are the plans to remedy the situation?
