## **Infrastructure Works in North East Arnhem**

- 1. The 2021/22 budget allocated the Central Arnhem Highway \$78.1 million budgeted for works.
  - a) Please advise how much was spent, and why there was a significant underspend?
  - b) According to this budget there is \$71 million in revoted works and \$49 million for new works does this mean that over the next financial year \$120 million will be spent on the Central Arnhem Highway?
  - c) Will this work prioritise the roads that benefit homeland and community residents of the region so that they can better access services and supplies?
- 2. Please provide an update on barge landings? What work has been done and when are these projects due to be completed for Galiwin'ku, Ramingining and Gapuwiyak?
- 3. Similarly the Aerodrome in Galiwin'ku has been listed for some time on the budget papers. Where is this project up to and when will it be completed?
- 4. Marine infrastructure works in Nhulunbuy is a revoted work that is part of an \$8 million joint project. The 2022/23 budget paper outlines there is also a \$10 million commitment to support public-private investment to improve the commercial wharf and landside facilities at the Gove deep water port. What is this \$10 million commitment dependent upon?
- 5. What new infrastructure works are announced in the 2022/23 budget for North East Arnhem Land?
