Mr Guyula to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

Infrastructure Works in North East Arnhem

1. The 2021/22 budget allocated the Central Arnhem Highway \$78.1 million budgeted for works.
 - a) Please advise how much was spent, and why there was a significant underspend?
 - b) According to this budget there is \$71 million in revoted works and \$49 million for new works – does this mean that over the next financial year \$120 million will be spent on the Central Arnhem Highway?
 - c) Will this work prioritise the roads that benefit homeland and community residents of the region so that they can better access services and supplies?
2. Please provide an update on barge landings? What work has been done and when are these projects due to be completed for Galiwin'ku, Ramingining and Gapuwiyak?
3. Similarly the Aerodrome in Galiwin'ku has been listed for some time on the budget papers. Where is this project up to and when will it be completed?
4. Marine infrastructure works in Nhulunbuy is a revoted work – that is part of an \$8 million joint project. The 2022/23 budget paper outlines there is also a \$10 million commitment to support public-private investment to improve the commercial wharf and landside facilities at the Gove deep water port. What is this \$10 million commitment dependent upon?
5. What new infrastructure works are announced in the 2022/23 budget for North East Arnhem Land?
