### QUESTION:

The Point Onshore Gas Information Portal has some really valuable information concerning the industry regulation and environmental framework. How many visitors have been to that website since it was brought online?

### ANSWER:

The Petroleum Onshore Information NT portal (POINT) is available to both the public and Northern Territory Government employees.

Access to POINT is anonymous and it is not possible to identify the number of unique users of the system. It is possible, however, to monitor user sessions and activity.

POINT was released for public use on 17/2/2021 and the systems for monitoring usage were established on 19/7/2021.

Between 19/7/2021 and 20/6/2022, the number of sessions per day have ranged between three and 21, for a total of 2848 sessions. The graph below provides a record of user activity on POINT for each month during this period.
