Mr Yan to the Minister for Health:

Aged Care

1. How many beds at Royal Darwin Hospital are currently being used for aged care?

As at 18 August 2022 there are 47 beds being used for aged care.

2. What is the average number of beds used for aged care purposes in Royal Darwin Hospital over the 2021/22 financial year?

Over 2021-22 on average 35 beds were occupied by patients waiting to be discharged to a residential aged care facility placement.

3. What is the longest time a person has been in a bed at a Territory hospital while waiting for discharge to supported accommodation or a nursing home?

The longest stay for a person currently waiting placement to a residential aged care facility is 1,700 days due to complex and very high care needs.
