(1) For a meeting, or part of a meeting, of the Board relating to disciplinary action the following applies:

(a) the legal member must preside;

(b) one of the following members of the Board must be present;

(i) the member appointed under section 104(1)(b)(i);

(ii) the member appointed under section 104(1)(b)(ii);

(c) a quorum is 3 members of the Board;

(d) a meeting may be held at the call of the legal member.

(2) A resolution of the Board in relation to disciplinary action may be made without a meeting if:

(a) at least 2 of the following members give written agreement to the resolution:

(i) the legal member;

(ii) the member appointed under section 104(1)(b)(i);

(2) The Auditor-General may, at any time, audit the financial statements and records in relation to a common fund.

(3) For subsection (2), the Auditor-General must, within 6 months after the end of each financial year, carry out an audit of each common fund.

(a) draw to the attention of the Minister any irregularity disclosed that, in the opinion of the Auditor-General, is of sufficient importance to justify doing so; and
