In 2013-14, the program expenditure of \$395 000, by Remote Bus Program area, was:

- Alice Springs: \$150 000
 Katherine: \$120 000
 Gove: \$125 000
- a. There are no current plans to extend the Northern Territory Government funded Remote Bus Program to other communities, however bus service operators may make commercial decisions to extend their services to other communities.
- b. As part of the ongoing six monthly reports from operators to the Department of Transport, as a requirement of the Remote Bus Program funding agreements, operators have regularly reported that passenger feedback has been positive in nature.

What is the status of the privatisation of Darwin Bus Service

Answer

On 12 December 2013, public tenders were advertised for the provision of bus services under transfer of business requirements established under the *Fair Work Act* and Regulations.

Tenders closed on 12 February 2014 and five companies submitted proposals.

Two companies have been shortlisted to commence further negotiations. The independent probity advisor to the process has indicated that I should provide no further comment other than to say it is progressing well.
