Annual Reports – Surveillance Devices

The Australian Crime Commission (ACC) is required to submit an annual report to you under section 59 of the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007* (NT) in relation to surveillance device warrants.

Please note that from 1st July 2016 The Australian Crime Commission (ACC) is now also known as the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC). The *Australian Crime Commission Act 2002* (Cth) and the regulations under that Act set out the legal foundation for the ACC/ACIC, including how the agency may be named as well as the functions, responsibilities and powers of the agency, its CEO, Board, examiners and members of staff.

During financial year 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2016, the ACC did not exercise powers under the Act. The enclosed report provides a nil return against the reporting provisions of the Act.
