The two actual totals on Page 1 and 2 of the tabled document, that is, 589 and 143, add up to 732. These two tables are, and purport only to be the total staffing numbers of the Crime and Operations Command. They do not include either the Services Command, the JDU, the Commissioner's Office or the PFES College. The Crime Command total did not include the TRG. As these two tables (Crime and Operations) include staff who are ACPO or Auxiliary, it is not valid to compare the total with the 742 number in the first mentioned table.
