Answer: The budgeted amount to be spent on known consultancies for DCIS in

2004-2005 is approximately \$1.9M, including local and interstate firms. Of this \$250,000 relates to whole of government short course training, sourced through panel contracts, where the agencies reimburse DCIS for the costs. Approximately \$865,000 relates to the employment of contract IT staff who reside in the agency and support PIPS and GAS. The balance covers such known requirements as expert advice/assistance with the Telecommunications tender, lease acquisition review, benchmarking of ICT contracts, project management, system enhancement and maintenance

and development of the ICT industry plan.
