How many new mothers leave hospital within 24 hours of giving birth?

ANSWER

Calculating this figure for all the NT public hospitals requires complex data analysis and validation, and is not done routinely.

However the Community Midwifery Program (CMP) in Darwin does keep this type of data. During the 2007 calendar year, 217 mothers gave birth as part of the CMP and 160 were discharged within 24 hours of giving birth.
