Number of visitors 1st July 2011 until 30 June 2012 (366 days) was 205,401

Number of visitors 1st July 2012 until 20 June 2013 was (355 days) was 169,154

To obtain a full year for comparison, a daily average of 476.5 was multiplied by the remaining 11 days to obtain a projected 366 days comparison of 174,395

Variation between Financial Year 11/12 and Financial Year 12/13 is expected to be 31,005.
