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**Answer:**

1. The list of projects attached (and being coordinated) include all known projects for each of the major communities funded by the Northern Territory, Australian Government, Shires, local community or private sector. The Projects are coordinated using a "placed based" approach so that the impact on the local community can be managed so as not to overwhelm the capacity of each community.
  2. Total number of NTG Infrastructure lots secured 756.  
Current Annual lease liability (value) is \$2 538 215.
  3. No license agreements are currently in place with the Land Councils.
  4. The Land Councils submit their accounts for lease payments directly to the leasing agencies being Department of Housing, Indigenous Essential Services Pty Ltd (part of Power and Water Corporation) and the Department of Corporate and Information Services on behalf of all other NT Government Agencies. These agencies pay their accounts direct to the Land Councils and the Department of Regional Development and Women's Policy does not keep details of these payments.
