ANSWER

Five firms submitted tenders in response to the request issued by the then Department of Planning and Infrastructure.

Four tenders were accepted and assessed against the tender specifications.

The fifth tender was not accepted because it was received after the deadline for the lodgement of tenders that had been specified in the tender documentation provided to each interested firm.

The firm in question lodged an appeal with the Procurement Review Board against the decision to exclude its tender. The appeal was rejected by the Board.
