Answer: Prisoner Services Units within the Alice Springs and Darwin Correctional

Centres are responsible for sentence management, support and

reintegration services and the direct delivery of treatment programs to

offenders.

The Prisoner Services Units also manage the provision of programs and services by external providers such as the Department of Health and Families and non-government organisations.

In addition, individual treatment / counselling is available to those offenders unable or unsuitable to participate in group programs due to low numbers (such as female offenders) or prisoners with low levels of literacy, or cognitive difficulties.

The budget for Prisoner Services at Darwin Correctional Centre in 2009-10 was \$1.845M.

The budget for Prisoner Services at Alice Springs Correctional Centre in 2009-10 was \$1.711M.
