2008–09, an increase of 90.9 per cent on 2007–08.

Some 74.5 per cent (952 persons) entered under the Employer Sponsored category. This was an increase of 165.2 per cent compared with 2007–08 (359 persons). The other major skilled category was Skilled Independent

(200 persons).
