A total of 28 organisations received five year funding agreements in 2017-18 totaling \$18 247 575 per annum.

**3. Why were individual organisations chosen to receive five year funding?**

Organisations were selected to enter into a five year funding agreement based on a variety of reasons including existing agreements expiring; alignment to NT Health strategic policy directions; limited services available in the community; co-commitment with Commonwealth Government.

**4. What organisations have received funding for less than five years and at what cost?**

In 2017-18, a total of 125 organisations received funding agreements for less than five years totaling \$46 198 891 per annum. In 2018-19, a total of \$12 603 672 has been allocated to 39 organisations on agreements less than five years.

**5. Why have they not received five year funding given this was an election commitment?**

The rationale for not renewing some grants for a five year funding term was based on a variety of reasons including review of grant activity; limited term projects; and shorter period granted to stagger the number of five year grants awarded to avoid all grants expiring at the same time.
