- 3. How many investigations are currently underway and how many were completed in 2017-18? What was the subject matter of those investigations and have any recommendations that were made been actioned by the government?

ANSWERS:

- 1. The Commission cannot respond to this question as compensation payments made through the Commission's process are subject to privilege.
- 2. As at 3 September 2018, 56 complaints were open.
