Question:

Can I get the FTE figures from the 11–12 period, which I have already been told is 1370, but could I get a break of that of which ones or how many are funded by the NT and who funds the balance of those?

Can I then get one for 2015–16 which was when you came into power, I think I was told 1412 and get the same breakdown—I know some of that changed in that period. Can I get the latest figures that we have got, giving us our current FTE—how many of those have funded by the NT and how many have funded by other sources? Can I also have when some of those agreements may run out?

Answer:

The table outlines the breakdown of the annual report figures by funding source.

The Commonwealth's NT Remote Aboriginal Investment National Partnership Agreement (NTRAI NPA) finishes at the end 2021-22.

In the current year the other minor items relate to Cross Border Family Violence Intelligence Model and Groote Eylandt Dog initiatives with funding for both finishing at end 2018-19. The Commonwealth has indicated an intent to continue both for a further three years and are working towards finalising this following the 2019 Federal election.
