


Our vision A prosperous, corruption-free Territory.
Our mission To support and empower Territorians to prevent, detect and respond to improper conduct.

The *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act* was passed in 2017.
The first NT Independent Commissioner Against Corruption, Kenneth Fleming QC, commenced on 2 July 2018 and established the Office of the ICAC (OICAC).
On 30 November 2018, the office started receiving reports of improper conduct.
Below is a snapshot of the OICAC’s outcomes to date.

933 reports received, containing 1079 allegations			
756 reports assessed	67 allegations under preliminary enquiry*	59 allegations referred to an agency for action*	620 reports containing 670 allegations closed
39 active investigations*	8 active joint investigations*	24 investigations finalised	4 referrals to Police/DPP
42 corruption prevention recommendations made	93% of recommendations accepted	39 recommendations under monitoring and review	2 audits underway
136 prevention initiatives delivered	3215 people attended information sessions	89% satisfaction with information sessions	4 public reports on investigations
