The first NT Independent Commissioner Against Corruption, Kenneth Fleming QC, commenced on 2 July 2018 and established the Office of the ICAC (OICAC).

On 30 November 2018, the office started receiving reports of improper conduct.

Below is a snapshot of the OICAC's outcomes to date.


933 reports received, containing 1079 allegations



Categories of allegation




Allegations by type of public body
