CCTV for Nhulunbuy

During June 2021 Estimates Hearnings the Minister advised that CCTV for Nhulunbuy would be provided during this term of Parliament. Many businesses in Nhulunbuy have suffered property damage and there have been fears for individual safety in Nhulunbuy town. At a town meeting in August last year, Community members were assured that the Government had released funding for CCTV however no CCTV has been provided since.

1. Please advise whether funds have been allocated for CCTV as part of the 21/22 budget?

ANSWER:

- Yes.
- Five new camera sites have been identified for installation. Twenty cameras and five audio kits.
- Previous scoped costs are being revalidated.
