2020-21 State of the Service

The 2020-21 State of the Service Annual Report tabled in Parliament last month showed that the NT Public Service has ballooned by 1,022 employees to 24,612 during 2020-21 despite the hiring freeze declared by the Chief Minister in 2018.

Questions:

- 1. How many of the 1,022 new employees were new positions?
- 2. What were the job levels of each position, what type of roles and what Departments were they attributed to?
- 3. How many of the 1,022 new employees are in frontline positions?
- 4. How many of the 1,022 new employees are on contract?
- 5. What is the breakdown of the position types?
 - Ongoing (Permanent) Full Time
 - Ongoing (Permanent) Part Time
 - Fixed (Temporary) Full Time
 - Fixed (Temporary) Part Time
 - Casual
- 6. In 2019-20 the NT public Service number grew by over 3,000 new employees. How many of these were frontline workers?
- 7. What increases are anticipated over the next 12 months and is there a budget contingency for this growth?
- 8. In 2018 the Chief Minister promised a hiring freeze. Is the hiring freeze still officially in place? If not, when did it officially end?
