- 1. Can you please detail how many individuals received the 'de-escalating and managing anti-social behaviour training'?
 - 42 enrolments, 18 completed
- 2. How many individual businesses had staff attend the training?
 - This data is not to hand as participants register under their unique student ID. Employer information is not provided as part of this process.
- 3. What was the total cost of delivering the training?
 - \$94,734 was provided to the Australian Retailers Association for the program. To cover up to 160 participants for a combination of online and face-to-face delivery.
 - (i) Of this cost how much was paid by DITT?
 - DITT covered the full cost of the training.
 - (ii) How much was paid for by businesses?
 - DITT covered the full cost of the training.
