De-Escalation Training

Further to the response to Written Question 615:

Question 9 - bullet point one states 'De-escalating and managing anti-social behaviour training is being delivered through to the end of 2023 through the Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade (DITT) by Registered Training Organisation, Australian Retailers Association.'

1. Can you please detail how many individuals received the 'de-escalating and managing anti-social behaviour training'?

- 42 enrolments, 18 completed

2. How many individual businesses had staff attend the training?

- This data is not to hand as participants register under their unique student ID. Employer information is not provided as part of this process.

3. What was the total cost of delivering the training?

- \$94,734 was provided to the Australian Retailers Association for the program. To cover up to 160 participants for a combination of online and face-to-face delivery.

(i) Of this cost how much was paid by DITT?

- DITT covered the full cost of the training.

(ii) How much was paid for by businesses?

- DITT covered the full cost of the training.
