Hit and run statistics

1. Could you provide the number of hit and runs recorded on NT roads for the financial years 2021-22, 2022-23 and the 2023-24 reporting period, and where these incidents happened?

a. of these hits and runs, how many were prosecuted?

Prosecutions have commenced for 32 of the 42 occurrences. In 31 occurrences a prosecution commenced for a hit and run driving charge. In one of the occurrences, a prosecution commenced but for a driving causing harm/death charge, rather than a hit and run charge.

b. of the cases that proceeded to prosecution, how many convictions were recorded?

To date, nine of the 32 occurrences have resulted in a conviction. 18 have cases still in progress, two resulted in a finding of guilt but no conviction, and three resulted in no finding of guilt.

2. What funding is allocated in the 2024-25 Budget to address the issue of hit and runs?

The NT Police has dedicated traffic branches, major crash investigative units, associated training and infringement units and the total cost incurred in 2023-24 in delivering services, including hit and run response and investigation, was \$11.447M.

In 2024-25 this will be escalated by wage growth for police officers and the associated logistic costs.
