I am writing to express my concern about the Territory Coordinator because I care deeply about good governance in the Northern Territory and want to protect our unique lifestyle.

The Territory Coordinator Bill is strongly opposed by the public, creates serious flaws in our decision-making process, is a totally unnecessary position and consolidation of power within the Minister for the Territory Coordinator - the Chief Minister, and puts our health and our unique and precious environment at serious risk. In exchange for this huge risk Territorians are being asked to take, the TC offers no tangible economic benefit to Territorians struggling with the cost-of-living crisis.

Recommendation:
