On the motion of Mr Ryan the following new clause was inserted in the Bill:

"3A. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after section 108 the following section:

'180A. A person shall not drive a motor vehicle to which a trailer is attached, being a trailer, the laden mass of which exceeds 1 tonne, unless the trailer is fitted with an independent braking system in accordance with item 7(4) in the Fourth Schedule'."

Clause 4 -

Mr Ryan moved as an amendment -

Omit the proposed new Item 7(4) and substitute the following:

"(4) Subject to sub-clause (5), where -

- (a) the unladen mass of a trailer exceeds 500 kilograms; or
- (b) in the opinion of the Registrar having regard to the length, construction and design of a trailer, the laden mass of the trailer is, at any one time, capable of exceeding 1 tonne,

the trailer shall have an independent braking system.

"(5) The independent braking system -

- (a) shall operate on at least 2 wheels of the trailer and be capable of stopping the trailer in the same manner as the motor vehicle; and
- (b) except where the trailer has a laden mass of less than 2 tonnes and has been fitted with overrider brakes, shall be capable of being operated from the driver's seat of the motor vehicle.

"(6) The Registrar may exempt a trailer from compliance with the provisions of sub-clause (4) if he is satisfied that, having regard to the length, construction and design of the trailer, the laden mass of the trailer is not likely, at any one time, to exceed 1 tonne."
