**Question:**

Is it possible to get statistics on the rate of Indigenous people employed within Housing and Community Development and further to that, how many of those are in management positions.

How many women are employed across Housing and Community Development?

**Answer:**

As at the 31 March 2017, the total headcount was 494 employees who identified themselves as ATSI working for the Department of Housing and Community Development. This figure includes all casual employees employed. The full time equivalent (FTE) was 156.67.

As at the 31 March 2017, there were nine staff, identified as ATSI, employed in management positions at the SAO1 level and above.

As at the 31 March 2017, the Department of Housing and Community Development had a headcount of 669 women employed. This total includes casual employees. The full time equivalent (FTE) count was 364.8.
