Resigned

For the 29 resignations in DCIS:

- 17 positions were filled
- 5 employees were on long leave prior to resigning and not in the workplace, with their nominal positions previously backfilled.
- 1 position was in progress and not yet filled (see response to question 4)
- 6 supernumerary employees in Shared Services resigned and standard recruitment action for nominal positions has been progressed.

Retired

For the two retirements:

- 1 person was taking leave prior to retirement and the nominal position was already filled.
- 1 position was filled.

Terminated

One temporary contract trainee was terminated. Trainee numbers maintained.

One position in Shared Services remained to be filled at 31 March 2017 with plans to fill the position in line with standard recruitment arrangements.

Procurement

1.

A pre-procurement Expression of Interest process, issued 5 April 2016 and closed 13 May 2016, sought submissions for the supply of up to 12 000 m² of office accommodation for the Department of Health for either the Darwin or Palmerston CBD. Following the EOI process, on 7 August 2016 the former government announced it planned to subsequently proceed to two select tender processes for 6 000 m² of office accommodation in each of the Darwin and Palmerston CBDs.

In December 2016, the government announced a new public tender process for a lease of 10 000 m² of office accommodation for the Department of Health in the Darwin CBD that would also support the government's efforts to revitalise the CBD.

2.

The Expression of Interest referenced an indicative timing of 2018-19.

Construction timeline for the current public tender process is mid-2021.
