Question: How much money has the Department of Lands and Planning put into the Kilgariff subdivision since 2012?

Answer:

The Department constructed headworks infrastructure to support the development of Kilgariff, with expenditure since 2012 including:

- \$1.2 million of Capital Works Program towards the completion the intersection on the Stuart Highway;
- \$3.7 million granted from appropriation to the Land Development Corporation for the construction of one lane of Harris Avenue, part of the trunk drainage, a sewer gravity main to service the development and a contribution towards public space;
- \$1.8 million from Capital Works Program for the duplication of Harris Avenue and extending the power and water connections for future stages; and
- \$187,000 from Minor New Works for the stabilisation of the batters on the Kilgariff trunk drain.
