Question: **Of the 12 schools which were unsuccessful in receiving approval for their exceptional circumstances application to be reimbursed through the department, how much was each individual application for and what was the circumstance for each individual application.**

Note that the minister accepted the question under condition that personal information is not given.

Answer:

- In 2015-16, the Department of Education provided two rounds for exceptional circumstances funding applications.
- A total of 25 applications were received from 21 schools, including four schools that applied in both rounds.
- Applications from 12 schools were approved for a total of \$776 955.
- Nine schools did not receive additional funding:
 - six schools' applications were not approved; and
 - three decisions were deferred pending further information from schools.
