Answer: The average cost is \$19,096.54.

This figure was derived from the average cost of the travel to sittings in the 2005 year, of the three Alice Springs based Members - Members for MacDonnell, Braitling and Greatorex.

It includes only payments for travel to sittings, not other entitlements such as party meetings, official functions, committees and travel outside the electorate.
