## **5.9 QUESTION ON NOTICE**

How many of those mothers that leave hospital within 24 hours of giving birth return to hospital with complication requiring re-admission including post natal depression?

## **ANSWER**

This is not a statistic that is routinely collected or reported on. Calculating this figure for the NT public hospitals would require complex analysis and data validation.

However the Community Midwifery Program (CMP) in Darwin does keep this data. During 2007, no mothers who gave birth as part of the CMP who were discharged within 24 hours of giving birth were readmitted to Royal Darwin Hospital with a complication.
