Through the Weed Risk Management System, Neem Trees have been addressed as having a vry high weed risk. NRETA is currently preparing a

detailed brief on the tree, which will then go to the Minister for

determination.

If the Minister declares it a weed, it will be banned from sale at nurseries

in the Northern Territory.
