Have you done any calculations on what the cost for power, water and sewerage would have been if Parliament House was still with PAWA rather than Q Energy and had been subject to the tariff increases?

### **ANSWER**

The Department of the Legislative Assembly purchases water and sewerage through Power and Water Corporation and there is no valid comparison to make.

The Department of the Legislative Assembly purchases electricity over a fixed contract period and the costs are contained within the contract. Price fluctuations which apply to domestic electricity consumers do not apply. The relevant comparison was made in conjunction with the supply of electricity tender process prior to commencement of the contract.
