data systems that capture all incidences of training across DHF.

From the DHF Corporate and Clinical Training Calendar, and through data provided by Divisions approximately 80% of training activities are carried internally and 20% of training activities are contracted out externally. Due to the diversity of the agency's training requirements and volume of training conducted, specialised training is often brokered externally by individual Work Units.

There are also a number of work unit based Educators who provide full time on the job training.
