Answered On: 17/06/2010  
Answer: The Department for Natural Resources, Environment, the Arts and Sport (NRETAS) removed trees from an 80m section of road 4-5 years ago.

Currently NRETAS controls seedlings/regrowth under these trees for 500m.

Re-growth of Poinciana will be treated with herbicide "Glyphosate".
