Answer: The NT Government has previously advised that it was not heritage listing the former Catalina base, including the ramp. The Land Development Corporation which had been developing the area was asked to commit a thorough archaeological survey of the Catalina base and Z force base. A significant interpretation facility is to be constructed somewhere at East Arm to inform people of the history of the area including the world war II history.

The archaeological survey is now close to completion.
