Facing the North Function – Canberra, Wednesday 19th September 2018

1. What was the total cost to the NT Government of planning and holding this function?

The Northern Territory Government and the Darwin Major Business Group are sharing a 50:50 costs contribution for the delivery of the event. These costs are currently estimated around \$80 000, of which the Northern Territory Government will contribute half.

2. How many people did the NT Government fund to travel to Canberra to attend the event?
