Lighting at the corner of Howard Springs Road and Stuart Highway

- There was a contract let during 2003/04 for providing lighting at the corner of Howard Springs
 Road and the Stuart Highway
 - (a) how long did it take for this contract to be completed;
 - (b) how long was it supposed to take;
 - (c) what was the contract price; and
 - (d) what did the job finally cost the government.

ANSWER

- (a) The contract took 19 weeks to complete. A Certificate of Practical Completion was issued on 29 January 2004.
- (b) The initial contract period was for 15 weeks.
- (c) The original contract price was \$172 410.55.
- (d) The final contract price was \$192 406.24. The increase was partly due to a misdiagnosed street lighting fault.
