Non Catalogue Services

How much did “non-catalogue” services cost the government in 2003/04?

ANSWER

For the purpose of our response to this question, “non-catalogue” services are assumed to be services that do not appear as a priced item within the CSC pricelist.

Specifically, “non-catalogue” items are those which do not appear under the headings of Desktops, Laptops, Printers, Printer Accessories, General Accessories, Software Cat 2 and Software Cat 3, Move Asset, Unsubscribe Asset and Support Services.

Given the above, “Non-catalogue” IT services purchased through CSC for 2003/04 totalled \$570,410.80.

\$520,632.04 of which relates to project work (time and materials). The balance of \$49,778.76 relates to non-catalogued products.
