The Alice Springs and Tennant Creek contracts covered work on all types of fixed and portable fire equipment on all Northern Territory Government assets. Expenditure on portable fire extinguishers cannot be readily extracted.

3. The Department of Transport and Works was responsible for fire safety.

Darwin, Gove and Katherine contracts covered work on all types of portable fire equipment in all Northern Territory Government assets. Expenditure for schools alone cannot be

readily extracted.

The Alice Springs and Tennant Creek contracts covered work on all types of fixed and portable fire equipment including security for schools. Expenditure on portable fire extinguishers cannot be readily extracted.

- 4. The Department of Transport and Works was responsible for the maintenance and servicing of fire detection and fire fighting equipment, as well as for determining the extent and adequacy of fire safety protection in schools before July 1991.
- 5. Responsibility for the maintenance and servicing of fire detection and fire protection systems lies with the Department of Transport and Works.
 - Responsibility for determining the extent and adequacy of fire detection and protection systems in schools, lies with the Northern Territory Fire Services.
- 6. Contracts for portable fire equipment cover work on all Northern Territory Government assets. Figures for schools alone cannot be readily extracted.
- 7. Contracts for portable fire equipment cover work on all Northern Territory Government assets. Figures for schools alone cannot be readily extracted.
- 8. For all regions a total of \$152 000 was budgeted in 1991/92 for the removal and/or replacement of BCF fire extinguishers in NT Government schools. All were removed by mid-1992.
