Mr Maley to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

New Youth Justice Centre at Holtze

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) awarded a tender for \$55 million to Halikos Pty Ltd to build the new Youth Justice Centre at Holtze.

Questions:

1. Has the current development had any project or design variations todate?

Yes.

2. If so, what are these project variations and their related costs?

Project variations can be attributed to matters including scope and design. Details remain Commercial-in-Confidence as the contract is still in progress.

3. How will these variations impact on the final cost of the project?

Funding is allocated based on matters such as scope and design.

4. How will these project variations impact on the timeline for this project?

The operational requirements of a detention centre are of foremost consideration in scheduling project works.

5. How many beds will be included in the new facility?

Operational requirements will direct bed numbers in the new facility.

6. Have there been any variations in the number of beds planned for the new facility? If so, what are these variations and their related costs?

7. Is this a maximum capacity or is there capacity to increase the number of beds if required?

8. Have there been any variations to the maximum capacity for the new facility? If so, what are these variations and their related costs?

Around 400 jobs will be supported through the Alice Springs and Darwin youth detention centre projects.

10. How many permanent staff will work in the new facility once it is completed and operational? How many are working at the current facility?

11. What is the expected annual operational cost of the facility once it is open? What is the annual operational cost of the current facility?
