At times when capacity is becoming limited in Royal Darwin Hospital morgue (e.g. 113 bays in use), additional capacity is sourced through an external service provider.

At times when capacity is becoming limited in Gove District Hospital morgue (e.g. 12 bays in use), transfers are arranged to Darwin morgue facilities.
