Ms Boothby to the Minister for Business, Jobs and Training:

Alcohol Secure and Safety Grant Program

1. **How many businesses have applied for the Alcohol Secure Grant for the period to 30 June 2023 since inception of the grant?**

19 businesses have applied.

2. **How many businesses have received the Alcohol Secure Grant for the period to 30 June 2023 since the inception of the grant?**

17 businesses were successful

3. **How many businesses applied for the Alcohol Secure Grant for the period to 30 June 2023 since the inception of the grant and were not awarded funding?**

Two (2) businesses were deemed ineligible

4. **How much was the total amount paid by NTG for this funding across all businesses for the period to 30 June 2023 since the inception of the grant?**

Businesses (applicant) can claim reimbursement of up to \$15,000 on costs as a 75% co-contribution on the agreed work as defined in the grant agreement between the applicant and the Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade (DITT).

As at 30 June 2023, no business had completed their works.

5. **Please provide a breakdown of the number of businesses who have installed additional security measures to secure stock against theft or damage?**
