J Davis to the Minister for Public Service, Hon Jo-Anne Hersey MLA:

Public sector reforms

1. The Attorney-General stated last year that every agency would be reviewed for systemic racism.
 - a. What is the timeline for completing reviews across the entire public service?
 - b. When do you expect all major departments to be reviewed?
2. How is progress of cultural reform across the NTPS being measured, particularly in agencies where reviews are complete or underway? Are there KPIs or cultural health benchmarks that are publicly reported?
3. The Chief Minister last year referenced the Kelly Review as a key cultural reform roadmap. How many of its recommendations have been implemented, and specifically, what progress has been made on the recommendations that address racism and culture within the NT Police Force?
4. What accountability has occurred within leadership for historic or recent racist conduct in the NT Government, including social media posts referenced during last year's Estimates? Has any disciplinary or corrective action been taken?
