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1. Purpose

The Defence Industry Council (the Council) is designed to facilitate engagement between the Chief Minister and local defence industry stakeholders to inform Government strategies and drive collaborative efforts to attract new defence opportunities to the Northern Territory.

The Council aims to:

1. Provide the Chief Minister with the opportunity to engage with local key industry stakeholders regarding defence and defence industry matters.
2. Ensure there is alignment between the Chief Minister, local industry and relevant government departments regarding defence industry strategy and priorities.
3. Provide a platform for key local industry stakeholders to contribute to the delivery of the Northern Territory's defence industry strategy and priorities.

2. Authority

The Council is a non-statutory advisory group, established by the Chief Minister. It holds no delegated power to act on behalf of the Chief Minister, or to commit the Chief Minister or Government to any actions.

3. Responsibilities

3.1. Chair

The Chair will be the Chief Minister. The Chair, with the assistance of the Department of the Chief Minister and Cabinet (CM&C), is responsible for leading and directing the activities of the Council. If the Chief Minister is unavailable, the Chair may be delegated at the Chief Minister's discretion.

3.2. Members

Members of the Council are responsible for contributing expertise and perspective to the activities of the Council.

3.3. Department of the Chief Minister and Cabinet

DefenceNT, within CM&C, will provide administrative and secretariat support to the Council.

4. Structure and membership

4.1. Membership

The Chief Minister will appoint members directly by letters of appointment. The following are the proposed standing members of the Council.

Non-members may be invited to attend meetings by the Chief Minister. Members of the DefenceNT Strategy Group may be invited to meetings as required.

The Chief Minister may amend the composition of the Council at any time to reflect its evolving needs.

5. Remuneration

Members will not be remunerated for their participation in the Council.

6. Confidentiality

Unless otherwise indicated, all papers and minutes are confidential.

The Council will determine what information or papers are marked for release at the end of each meeting, or in subsequent meetings.

7. Resignation

Members may resign from the Council at any time.

All resignations must be provided in writing to the Chief Minister, through the Secretariat, for administration purposes.
